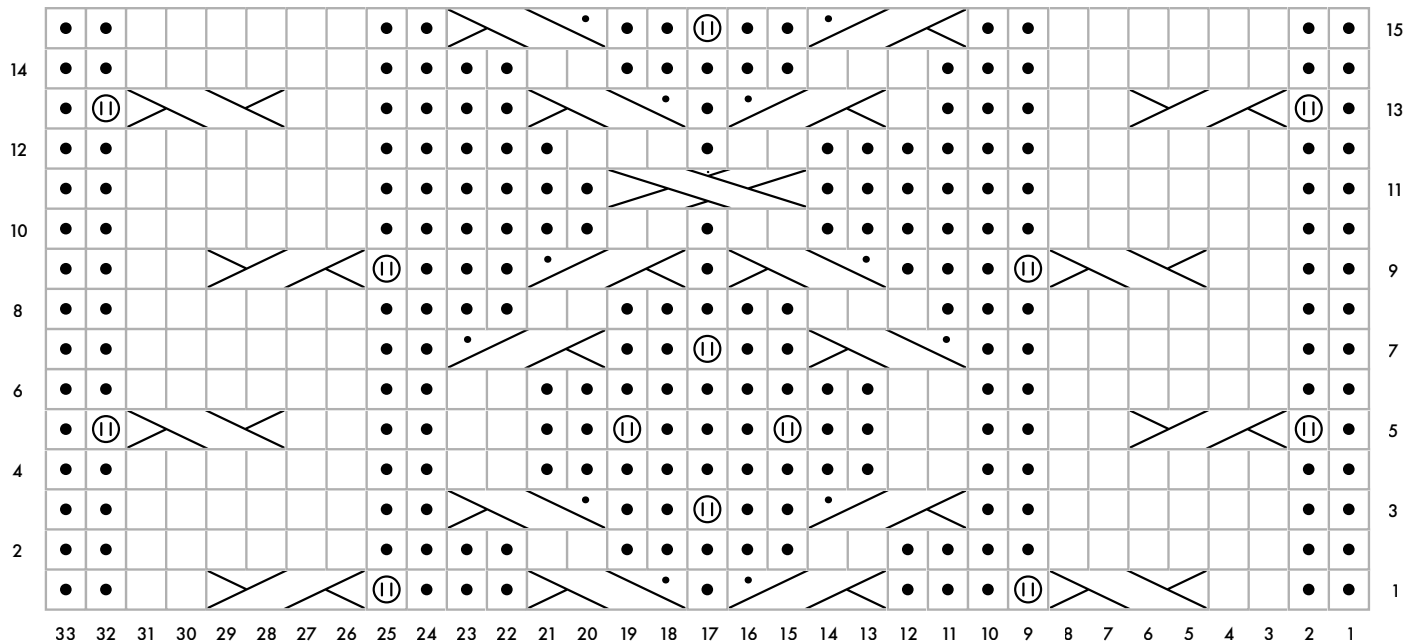




Cable Bobble Chart



Key & Explanation

□ RS: knit
WS: purl

● RS: purl
WS: knit

⓪ 5-stitch bobble: (K1, YO, K1, YO, K1) into the stitch, turn. Purl 5 sts, turn. Sl1, K4, then pass 4 stitches on the right over onto the 5th stitch.

T4B: Twist 4 sts back - Place the next 2 sts onto cable needle, hold at the back of work, K2 from the left needle, P2 from the cable needle.

T4F: Twist 4sts front - Place the next 2 sts onto cable needle, hold at the front of work, P2 from the left needle, K2 from the cable needle.

5-stitch left cross (2/1/2 LPC): Place the next 3 sts onto cable needle, hold at the front of work, K2 from the left needle, counting from the left, purl the first stitch on the cable needle (this will be the central purl stitch), then knit the rest of the 2 sts from the cable needle from the right.

C4B: Cable 4sts back - Place the next 2 sts onto cable needle, hold at the back of work, K2 from the left needle, K2 from the cable needle.

C4F: Cable 4 sts front - Place the next 2 sts onto cable needle, hold at the front of work, K2, from the left needle, K2 from the cable needle.
